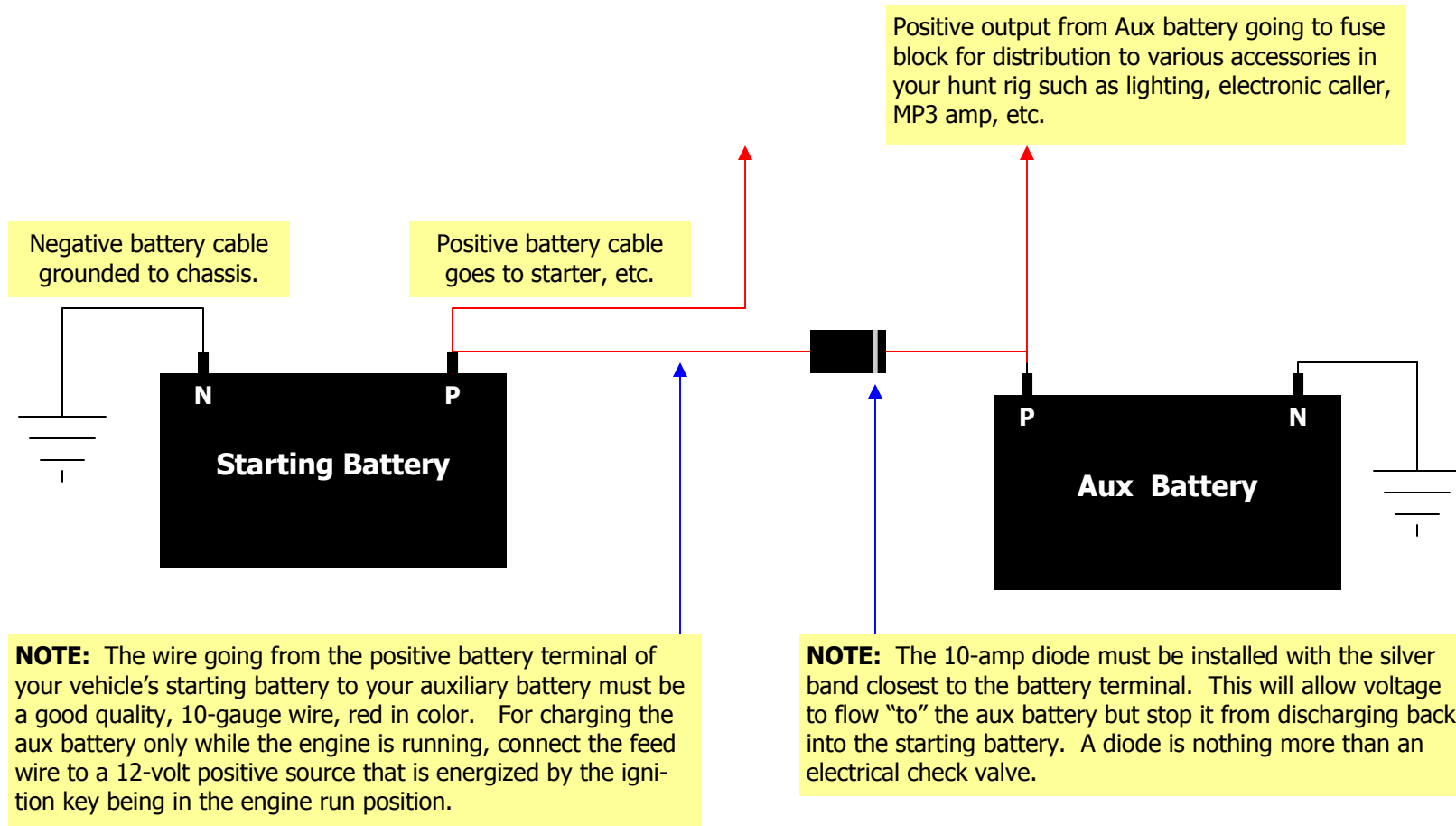


Wire in an auxiliary battery for your lights and calling accessories. By Red Barbarossa



This is a very simple system that will last forever. There are no active devices and since you are not using this auxiliary battery for engine cranking or other extremely heavy loads, it will stay charged while using hunt lights, other auxiliary lighting, calling amplifiers, etc. Please be sure to use good quality crimp connectors that are properly sized for the #10 wire and the battery post connections. Remember too that your feed wire size from your auxiliary battery to your distribution center must be of the proper size (minimum of #10 gauge) to support your accessory loads. Your ground wire must be of the same gauge or a heavy ground strap. If in doubt, contact me. Diodes will be available through www.redhunterllc.com. Or, drop me a note and I will help you source one.
